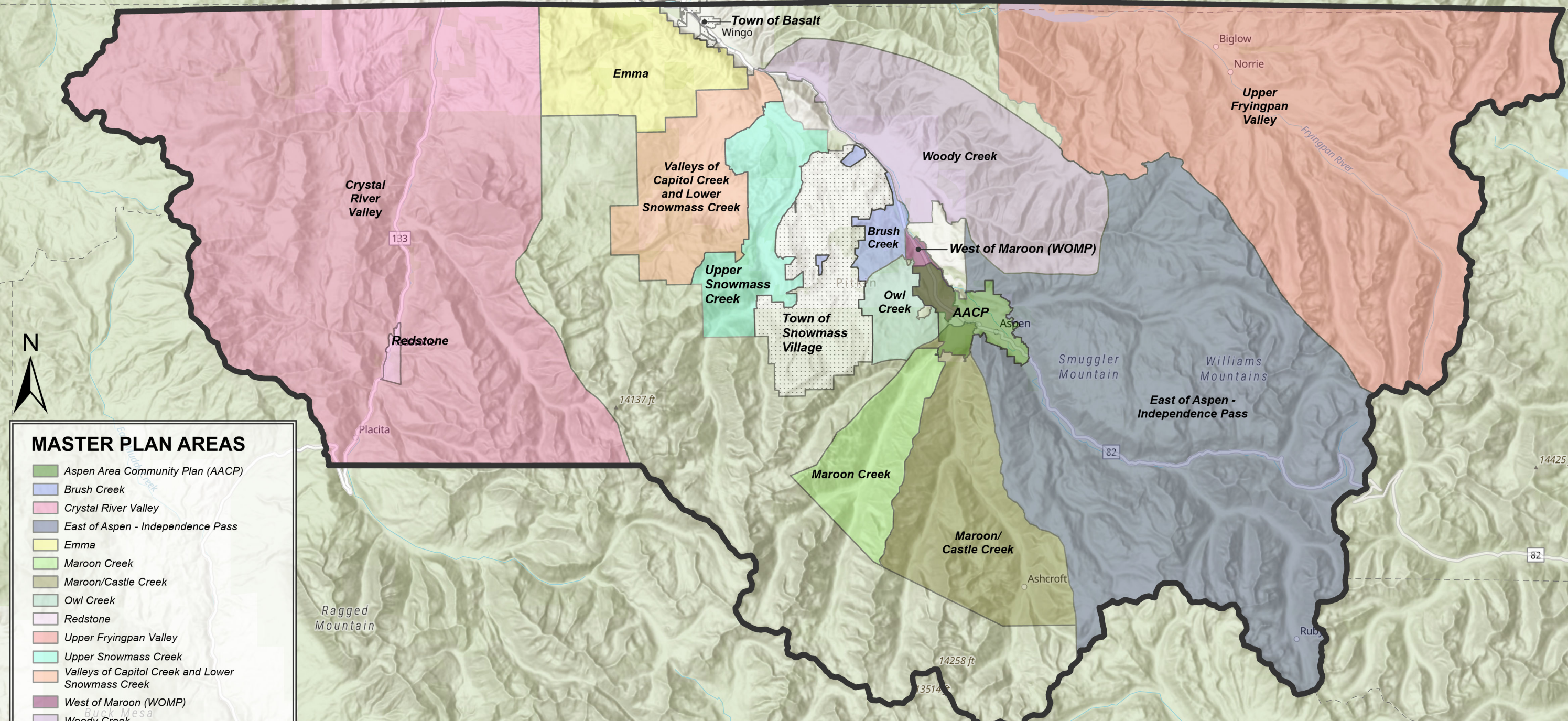


PITKIN COUNTY MASTER PLAN AREAS
